Bermuda also offers a number of key lifestyle benefits, including an amazing climate, quick commutes and a great expat community of like-minded professionals.

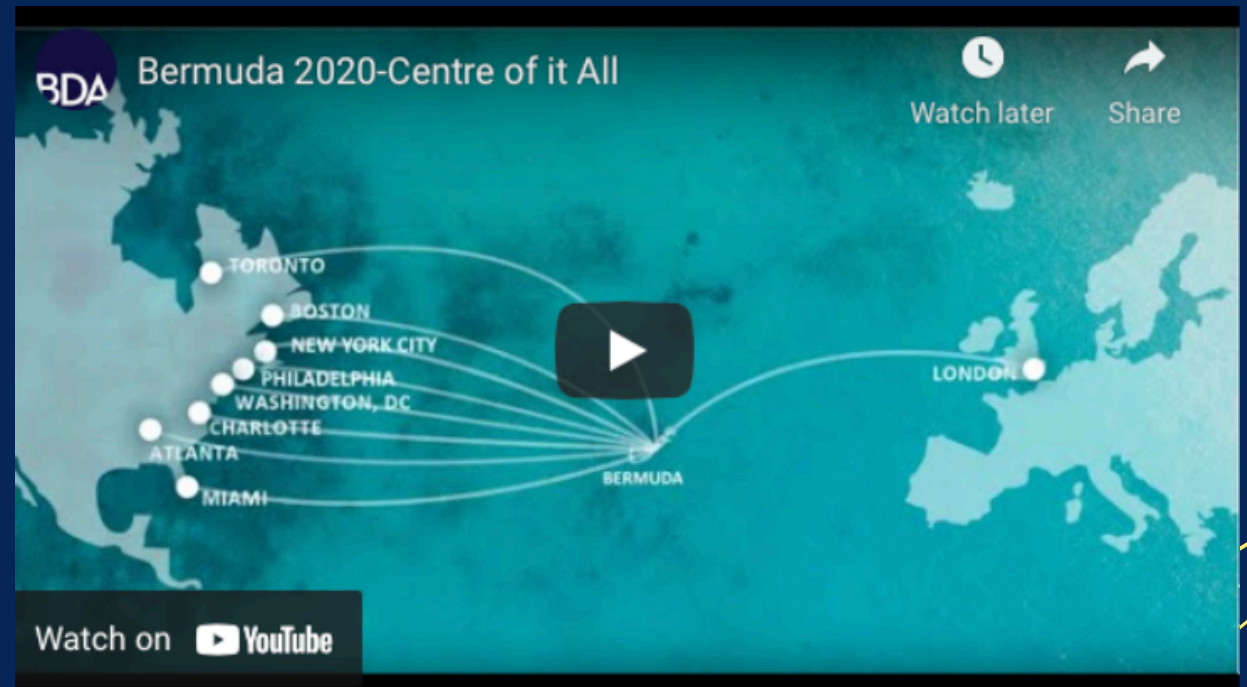

MORE ABOUT THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

The fact that the Cayman Islands are one of the biggest offshore tax havens has only led more expatriates to settle down here over the years. Most citizens, expats in The Cayman Islands and settlers in the territory have come here from the United Kingdom, the United States, Jamaica, and Canada, and they, therefore predominantly speak English.

The economy of the Cayman Islands is dominated by financial services and tourism, together accounting for 50-60% of Gross Domestic Product. The nation's low tax rates have led to it being used as a tax haven for corporations; there are 100,000 companies registered in the Cayman Islands, more than the population itself.
